On the 85th Anniversary of the Church Holy Trinity, Los Angeles, CA [2 Nov.2025]

At the Banquet (20-minute program: 2:40–3:00 pm)

Introductory Speaker – Ion Anton

Mr. Ion Anton opens with a preamble and introduces Mr. Dorian Şerban, the presenter of the event. In his introduction, Mr. Anton highlights the connection between two generations of the community: the older generation and the newcomers who arrived in America after 1980.

He mentions that Dorian Şerban joined the Holy Trinity Church only two months after the arrival of Fr. Constantin Alecse in Los Angeles in 1982, at the age of about 15. Dorian quickly established himself as a true youth leader, actively participating with his family in church life, social work, and collaborations with other young people in activities organized by the parish and by the Romanian-American Society "Viitorul Roman," run by Jon and Stella Cepoi.

Dorian Şerban's contributions included hosting artists and notable personalities from Romania, helping promote Romanian culture in the diaspora.

Ion Anton concludes: "It gives me special pleasure to hand over the microphone to none other than Mr. Dorian Serban."

Dorian Şerban stresses that his overview will focus on the period after 1980, as earlier parish activities are documented in the 50th anniversary volumes – English and Romanian - compiled by Vee and Suzan Petrescu (English version) and by Mr. Miron Butariu (Romanian version), presented to the community at the 50th Anniversary banquet, in June 1989. He highlights the "golden period" of 1980–1995, when the Holy Trinity Romanian Church in Los Angeles was a hub of Romanian religious, cultural and social meetings and activities.
